Function: The Macomb Orchard Trail Commission, formed in July 2002, is charged with acquiring and converting the abandoned railroad into a 24 mile equestrian, bicycling and walking trail. The Commission is composed of Macomb County, Huron-Clinton Metroparks and the communities along the trail. Each organization has a representative on the Commission who is actively involved in the development and maintenance of the trail. The Commission, along with the support of the Friends of the Macomb Orchard Trail and Michigan Rails-to-Trails Conservancy, research, plan and direct further development of the trail.
